

Coat of arms pictures from top to bottom and from left to right:

1 = Seal of John of Moos around 1387 in the canton of Uri (HBLs , v. Moss)

2 = Seal fragment of Wilhelm von Moos, Lucerne, 1556

3 = coat of arms of the house " Metzgerrainle 8" in Lucerne of Peter von Moos 1672, stone carving from a block of sandstone on the facade.

4 = Moos coat of arms in Landmann- gender Aptly named Thomas .

5 = coat of arms drawing of the Offices and local historian M. Styger, Schwyz (1856-1935), owned by E. Eichholzer, Vellano TI , son of Marie (Anna Karolina) Eichholzer - Immoos .

6 = helmet plate owned by Antonia Immoos, Fountain (electronically processed by the author RI)

7 = Coat slice of Moos / Immoos in the house Minerva Gersau

8 = Coat of arms carved Moos, Restaurant Schwyzerstübli in Schwyz, 1500

9 = -colored coat of arms of Moos in the Glacier Garden Lucerne

10 = Moos coat of arms in the form of an old house brand with upper case M and two stars fringed patriarchal cross; presumably Moss by train, by a unknown author; Staweb, graphic collection (Stasz).

11 = Coat of arms of Moser of Schwyz, called Präster from Appenzell, recorded sojourners, not belonging to the Immoos! (Illustration: Aptly named pastor Th. Fassbind)

12 = Coat of arms of Gugelberg of Meienfeld GR, called Gugelberg of Moos, of Andermatt, at the March in Ausserschwyz settled on Gugelberg, then pulled Meienfeld .

No. 10, 11 and 12 are not Immoos crest!
